


LADBROKE EASTER TRAIL

1. PALM SUNDAY

Did you know... On Palm Sunday we celebrate Jesus riding into Jerusalem on a young donkey. People waved big palm leaves as he arrived.

Activity What is the biggest leaf you can find on the way to the next point?

2. IN THE TEMPLE

Did you know... Jesus knocked over the tables where people had to change their money to buy offerings for God. He was very angry because the money-changers were robbing people of their savings.

Question What makes you angry?

3. WASHING THE DISCIPLES' FEET

Did you know... It was usually a servant's job but before they ate Jesus washed the feet of his friends to teach them that they should serve and help others.

Question Who have you helped this week?

4. THE LAST SUPPER

Did you know... This was the last meal that Jesus shared with his friends before he died. He told them to remember him when they ate bread and drank wine in the future.

Question What's your favourite meal?

5. GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE

Did you know... After supper Jesus went with his friends to a garden called Gethsemane to pray. Soldiers came and arrested him there.

Activity Can you say your own prayer to God?

6. PETER'S DENIAL

Did you know After Jesus was arrested Peter was scared. He told people he did not know Jesus. When the cock crowed 3 times Peter remembered Jesus had said this would happen.

Activity Can you hear the sound of any birds?

7. THE CRUCIFIXION

Did you know... Even though Jesus had done nothing wrong he was mocked and given a crown of thorns to wear and executed on a cross between 2 thieves.

Activity Can you see any sharp thorns or spikes on plants as you go to the next point? Be careful! Or find 2 twigs to make a cross to remind you Jesus' death.

8. THE EMPTY TOMB

Did you know When Mary went to visit the tomb where they had buried Jesus' body the large stone in front had been rolled away. Then Jesus appeared, he was alive and Mary was very surprised!

Activity Can you give each other a lovely surprise?

9. GOD WITH US TODAY

Did you know Jesus stayed on the earth for a short time after coming back to life. After he returned to heaven, God sent the Holy Spirit to inspire Jesus' followers. Many people still follow Jesus today and know his love in their lives.



Activity Please add something to the display on Psalm 23.
