Faberge egg

- Decorate a hard boiled egg (or a blown & washed egg shell) with ribbon and self adhesive “sparkles”

Edible Easter Garden

- Use a washed $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$ eggshell.
- Make a tiny cross from a small thin twig and yarn.
- Fold or scrunch up a clean tissue and put it in the eggshell, add water so it is quite damp, add the cross, sprinkle on some cress seeds.
- Place on a bright windowsill, check daily and water as required.
- The cress should germinate in a couple of days and be ready to cut in 4 to 6 days. You could add it to a salad or to egg sandwiches.

Eggheads

- Use a hard boiled egg or a washed and dried $\frac{3}{4}$ eggshell turned upside down
- Draw on a face.
- Add hair, either drawn on or made from yarn
